All submissions will be adjudicated in terms of the Mkhondo Local Municipality's Procurement Policy and Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No 5 of 2000 as well as the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022 (PPR 2022). The 80/20 Price and Specific goals Point System will be applicable for this tender. A total of 15 preference points shall be allocated on proportional or pro rata basis for contracting an enterprise owned by historically disadvantaged persons or individuals who meet the Requirements and a total 0f 5 preference points shall be allocated on a proportional or pro rata basis for implementing of programmes. The Council reserves the right not to award the RFQ to the lowest bid or not at all or in part.

Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulation, 2022 and Supply Chain Management Policy of Mkhondo Local Municipality will apply in the adjudication process. According to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No.5 of 2000, the 80/20 Price and Preference Point System will be applicable for this RFQ.

A maximum of 20 Preference Points will be allocated for specific goals. A total of 15 preference points shall be allocated on a proportional or pro-rata basis for contracting an enterprise owned by historically disadvantaged persons or individuals. A total of 5 points will be allocated on enterprises regarded as EMEs located within the local area of jurisdiction.
